

XII “Stellantis&You” Port de Palma Triathlon Mallorca 2026

Regulations.

1. The Club Marathon Mallorca, as organizer, under the technical direction of the FETRIB, will organize the XII “Stellantis&You” Port de Palma Triathlon Mallorca 2026, scheduled for next September 20, 2026 starting at 08:30 hours. This event will be coordinated and produced by Elitechip. This new edition is the continuation of the Triathlon project that every year runs through the most emblematic streets of Palma and begins in the waters of Can Pere Antoni beach.

Rules and regulations:

This event is governed by the rules and regulations established by the Balearic Islands Triathlon Federation (FETRIB) and by any special adaptation conditions that the event organizers may consider

2. The event consists of an Olympic, Sprint and Super Sprint distance Triathlon with the following distances:

- Olimpica: Swimming 1.500 m - Cycling: 40 km - Running: 10 km
- Sprint: Swimming 750 m - Cycling: 20 km - Running: 5 km
- Super Sprint: Swimming 350 m - Cycling: 10 km - Running: 2.5 km

3. Registration will be done through the website www.triatlonpalma.es and www.elitechip.net/es/triatlonpalma22 starting on November 1, 2025 and ending on September 17, 2026 at 11:59 p.m.

- 3.1. Any athlete who does not have a yellow chip (ChampionChip My-Laps) will have to rent a reusable one in advance at a cost of 2 euros.

- 3.2. Triathletes who are not members of the Balearic Islands Triathlon Federation or the Spanish Triathlon Federation will have to take out a one-day insurance policy for the price of 5 euros in order to participate. All team participants who are not members of the federation will have to pay a one-day licence for each of their members (4 € per non-member participant)

3.3. Prices:

- 3.4. From January 1st to March 31st, prices will increase by €3 for all distances. From April 1st to May 31st the price will increase by €7, from June 1st to July 31st the prices will increase by €7 and from August 1st the prices will increase by €6 over the previous price. Discounts for clubs send an email to web@elitechip.net, and discount vouchers will be sent provided the requirements are met (minimum 10 participants).

Registration for the race is personal and non-transferable and implies acceptance of the regulations and all its articles. Each participant takes part in the race under his or her own responsibility and has sufficient physical condition and technical mastery to face it.

4. Registration for the race entitles participants to participate in the race, a bib, a swimming cap, a commemorative T-shirt or gift, a Finisher's medal and refreshments during and after the race.

5. By registering, participants cede to the organization the rights to the image and sounds that are recorded during the event for the promotion or dissemination of the event.

6. Participants accept the use and processing of their personal data in accordance with the regulations to receive specific information about the event, its sponsors, and everything related to this sporting event and its subsequent editions.

7. In the event that due to adverse weather or other factors the planned distances cannot be run, the organization will carry out an alternative test in agreement with the judges of this event.

8. The event will be timed with the My Laps chip system, so the chip must be worn on the ankle with a velcro strap provided by the organization in case of not having one of their own. Not wearing the chip during the event will be grounds for disqualification and not appearing in the classifications.

9. The collection of bib numbers will take place on September 19 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the PEUGEOT “STELLANTIS&YOU” PALMA dealership, located at Calle Aragón number 191. Collection of bib numbers will not be allowed on the day of the event.

2. The race will be timed with the My Laps chip system, so the chip must be worn on the ankle with a velcro strap provided by the

organisation in case you do not have your own. Not wearing the chip during the race will result in disqualification and not being included in the classifications.

3. Race numbers will be collected on 19 September from 10:00 to 13:00 at the PEUGEOT "STELLANTIS&YOU" PALMA dealership, located at Calle Aragón number 191. Race numbers will not be collected on the day of the race.

4. Drafting (riding on the wheel) will be allowed in the cycling section of the race according to current FETRIB regulations. If necessary, the organisation reserves the right to modify this point.

5. Cancellations to the race will only be accepted for registered athletes who notify us before August 31, 2025 by email at info@elitechip.net. The refund will be 75% of the amount paid for registration.

REGISTRATIONS. EXCEPTIONAL MEASURES

Below, we offer runners the following options:

1. In the event of definitive suspension of the 2026 edition due to the health crisis or other provisions or emergencies not attributable to the organization, all those registered for any of the events of the XII "Stellantis&You" Port de Palma Triathlon Mallorca 2026, will automatically be registered for the 2027 edition without having to do anything.

2. Vouchers for the full amount of the registration can also be purchased for events organized by the company Elitechip SL. In this case, participants must contact us by writing to: info@elitechip.net

3. As a last resort, you can request a refund of 75% by returning the total amount of the race number to the same bank card number used to make the payment and the remaining 25% in VOUCHERS to participate in competitions organized by the company Elitechip S.L.

Note from the organization: After a deep reflection in which the center of our thoughts has been to offer the maximum facilities to our participants in a fair and equitable way, we have adopted this formula to be able to alleviate the irrecoverable and duly justified expenses that the organization of the event requires of us both at a material and human level.

6. Any athlete who wants to make a claim must present it in writing with a deposit of 50 euros for it to be accepted for processing. The deposit will only be returned if the claim is in favour of the claimant.

7. The categories of the race will be according to the regulations of the Spanish Triathlon Federation. Likewise, the absolute category will be established, which will be only for the first 3 absolute male and first 3 absolute female.

- Absolute male and female (first 3)
- Junior (18-19 years)
- Under-23 (20-23 years)
- Veteran 1 (40-49 years)
- Veteran 2 (50-59 years)
- Veteran 3 (60 or more years)

For the Super-sprint distance there will only be the absolute category, there being no classifications by age categories.

For the relay category the following categories will be established

- Male category
- Female category
- Mixed category

8. There will be trophies for the first 3 absolute category of the Olympic, Sprint and Super Sprint distances. The winners of the age categories of the Olympic and sprint events will receive a medal that will be awarded to the first, second and third in each category, as well as the relay teams.

OTHER PROVISIONS

- The organization will have a Civil Liability insurance to cover the entire event.
- At 08:30 hours Olympic Distance (the time may be changed depending on the number of registrations, to improve conditions).
- At 09:15 departure for the participants of the Sprint distance.
- At 09:30 departure for the participants of the Super-Sprint distance.
- The refreshment points in the foot race will be the following: there will be 2 refreshment points, distributed around the circuit and which will be located approximately 2/2.5 km apart from each other.
- The control of the race will be carried out by the FETRIB judges (Balearic Triathlon Federation).
- All participants must wear a swimming cap and helmet approved for use in the cycling sector.
- They must also use all the numbers and identification elements provided by the organization in accordance with the regulations of the Spanish Triathlon Federation.
- The organization reserves the right to modify the itinerary if circumstances dictate it.
- Timing will be carried out using the chip system.

- All participants will accept these regulations by registering.

RELAYS

- All the rules for this competition will be the same as those for the individual competition.
- Participants will wear caps and numbers of different colors to distinguish them.
- The relay team will be made up of 3 athletes, each of whom will do a section: swimming, cycling and running.
- The relay will be the time control chip, which each relay rider must wear on their ankle.
- The relay will take place in the pit area.

CIRCUITS: OLYMPIC

Swimming: Triathletes will do 2 laps of 750 m. by the bay of Port de Palma, in the area of Playa de Can Pere Antoni. The start and finish will be in this area, duly marked with buoys, canoes, zodiacs and boats from the health services that will ensure the safety of the participants.

T1 Swimming-cycling: After finishing the swimming, and entering the pits to pick up the bike, you will have a box at your disposal to leave all the swimming equipment, and to change into the cycling equipment. Afterwards you can pick up the bike and start the cycling section to complete the 40 kilometres.

Cycling: The circuit will consist of 6 laps of 6.6 kilometres, completing 40 km on a circuit along the seafront of the port of Palma.

The cycling section will be completely closed to traffic. The triathlete must respect the traffic regulations at all times, and ride on the right.

T2 Cycling-running: After finishing the cycling section, you must enter the pits and leave the bike in the same pick-up place. You cannot take off your helmet until you have left the bike in its place. You can take your running shoes from your box and start the 10-kilometre running section.

Running: The running race will consist of 2 laps to complete the total distance of 10 kilometres. There will be a refreshment station every 2.5 kilometres, approximately. The route covers the entire Façana Marítima de Levante from Paseo del Portixol to Camí de s'Escollera. On each lap you will pass through a chip control to count the laps. After completing the second lap you will have to turn towards the FINISH line to finish the Triathlon at Moll de Troneras del Portixol.

CIRCUITS: SPRINT

Swimming: Triathletes will do 1 lap of 750 m. around the bay of Port de Palma, in the area of Playa de Can Pere Antoni. The start and finish will be in this area, duly marked with buoys, canoes, zodiacs and boats of the health services that will ensure the safety of the participants.

T1 Swimming-cycling: At the end of the swimming, and entering the pits to pick up the bike, you will have a box at your disposal to leave all the swimming equipment, and to be able to change into the cycling equipment. Afterwards you can pick up the bike and start the cycling section to complete the 20 kilometres.

Cycling: The circuit will consist of 3 laps of 6.6 kilometres, completing a total of 20 km on a circuit along the promenade of the port of Palma. The cycling section will be completely closed to traffic. The triathlete must respect the traffic regulations at all times and ride on the right.

T2 Cycling-running: At the end of the cycling section, you must enter the pits and leave the bike in the same pick-up place. You cannot take off your helmet until you have left the bike in its place. You can pick up your running shoes from your box and start the 5-kilometre race section.

Running: The running race will consist of 1 lap to complete the total distance of 5 kilometres. There will be a refreshment station every 2.5 kilometres, approximately. The route covers the entire Façana Marítima de Levante from Paseo del Portixol to Camí de s'Escollera. At the turning point you will go through a chip control to count the partial times. After completing the first lap you will have to turn towards the FINISH line to finish the Triathlon at Moll de Troneras del Portixol.

CIRCUITS: SUPER SPRINT

Swimming: Triathletes will do a 350m lap around the bay of Port de Palma, in the area of Playa de Can Pere Antoni. The start and finish will be in this area, duly marked with buoys, canoes, zodiacs and boats from the health services that will ensure the safety of the participants.

T1 Swimming-cycling: After finishing the swimming, and entering the boxes to pick up the bike, you will have a box at your disposal to leave all the swimming equipment, and to change into the cycling equipment. Afterwards you can pick up the bike and start the cycling section to do the 10 kilometres.

Cycling: The circuit will consist of 2 laps of 6.6 kilometres, completing a total of 13 km on a circuit along the seafront of the port of Palma. The cycling section will be completely closed to traffic. The triathlete must respect the traffic regulations at all times and ride on the right.

T2 Cycling-running: At the end of the cycling section, you must enter the pits and leave the bike in the same place where you picked it up. You cannot take off your helmet until you have left the bike in its place. You can take your running shoes from your box and start the 2.5 kilometre running section.

Running: The running race will consist of 1 short lap to complete the total distance of 2.5 kilometres. The route covers the entire Façana Marítima de Levante from the Paseo del Portixol until past the Cuesta del Gas intersection with Avenidas where you will turn 180° and go back towards the Paseo del Portixol and you will head towards the FINISH LINE to finish the Triathlon at the Moll de Troneras del Portixol.

CANCELLATION OF THE SWIMMING SEGMENT DUE TO WEATHER REASONS.

If there are extreme weather conditions, such as strong winds, rain, etc.

The Technical Delegate and/or the Medical Delegate may decide on the length of the swimming segment or even the cancellation of said segment. The final decision will be made 1 hour before the start and will be clearly communicated to the athletes on the official Facebook profile of the competition as well as by public address system.

In case of cancellation of the swimming segment, the triathletes will be informed that the triathlon will become a duathlon with the following distances:

- Olympic: 10 km run + 40 km bike + 5 km run.
- Sprint: 5 km run + 20 km bike + 2.5 km run
- Super Sprint: 2.5 km run + 10 km bike + 1.25 km run

The start time will be as stipulated with a delay of 15 minutes.

POSSIBILITY OF USING A WETSUIT

Athletes aged 50 or over are allowed to participate in a wetsuit regardless of the water temperature.

If there are extreme weather conditions, such as strong winds, rain, or jellyfish, etc.

The Technical Delegate and/or the Medical Delegate may decide on the length of the swimming segment and the use of a wetsuit. The final decision will be made 1 hour before the start, and will be clearly communicated to the athletes on the official Facebook profile of the competition, as well as by public address system.

The official water temperature will be measured in the middle of the course, and at two other points of the swimming segment, and at a depth of 60 cm, 1 hour before the start. The lowest temperature taken will be considered the official one.

Water Temperature

The use of a wetsuit may be mandatory, permitted or prohibited, depending on the distance (in metres) and the water temperature (in C°) expressed in the following table:

| <u>Distance</u> | <u>Prohibited above</u> | <u>Mandatory below</u> |
|-----------------|-------------------------|------------------------|
| 800 mts | 22°C (age groups) | 15.9°C (age groups) |
| 1,900 mts | 24.6°C (age groups) | 15.9°C (age groups) |

(*) Note: The temperatures specified are not always the water temperatures used in the final decision. If the external temperature is lower than the water temperature, then the adjustment is to lower the measured water temperature, 0.5°C for every 1°C difference between the external and water temperatures.

COLLECTION OF BIB NUMBER / RUNNER'S BAG

- Along with the delivery of the bib number, the runner's bag will also be provided, which includes: swimming cap and commemorative T-shirt of the 2026 edition and other gifts from potential collaborators

- The collection of bib numbers will take place on Saturday, September 19th from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the PEUGEOT "STELLANTIS&YOU" headquarters at Calle Aragón 191 in Palma

BOXES / CHECK IN & CHECK OUT

All participants and teams must check in (bikes and race materials) during the times and schedules stipulated.

TIMETABLES:

OLYMPIC CHECK-IN: This check-in must be held on Saturday, September 19, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

SPRINT: Sunday, September 20, from 7:45 a.m. to 9:10 a.m. SECOND SPRINT ROUND

SUPER SPRINT: Sunday, September 20, from 7:45 a.m. to 9:25 a.m. SECOND SUPER SPRINT ROUND

CHECK-OUT: Check-out time per participant: 5 min. 11:00 a.m. - OLYMPIC: 12:00 p.m. - SPRINT and SUPER SPRINT

STARTS

A corridor with different rows of runners separated from each other will be set up until reaching the starting point.

FINISH LINE ENTRANCE

To avoid crowds, a closed post-finish area will be set up with an exit channel.

WARDROBE:

There will be a cloakroom service that will look after the belongings participants leave in their bags and backpacks:

- Sportswear to change into after the competition, towels, personal toiletries, food, etc.
- The organization will not be responsible for valuables left in these bags by participants: cell phones, tablets, computers, watches, chronometers, wallets with money or personal documents (credit cards, ID cards, passports), jewelry, etc
